We know that we are in it for the long haul. With 10+ years of support committed to each child and a network connecting youth, alumni, volunteers, supporters, board members and partners, the Fiver community will be supporting one another long after COVID-19 is behind us.

As we reflect on 2019 in this Annual Report and thoughtfully learn from the lessons of 2020, we will hold onto these core tenets. Regardless of the shape they take, they will always represent the essential components of the Fiver experience.

HISTORY & MISSION

HISTORY: Fiver takes its name from Richard Adam's celebrated work of fiction *Watership Down*. The novel focuses on the survival, leadership, and courage of a group of rabbits, led by the visionary rabbit Fiver, who set out to find a better way of life. Inspired by this story, Founder and Chairman of the Board, Tom Tucker, established the Foundation in 1998 and opened doors to kids in 2000. What began as a summer camp has evolved into a comprehensive, award-winning, youth development organization.

MISSION: The Fiver Children's Foundation is a comprehensive youth development organization that makes a 10-year commitment to children from underserved communities throughout New York City and central New York. Through character-building summer and year-round out-of-school time programs, Fiver empowers children to make ethical and healthy decisions, to become engaged citizens, and to succeed in school, careers, and life.

THE FIVER MODEL:

THREE PATHWAYS: Students from economically disadvantaged circumstances are referred at age 8 and stay involved until high school graduation. Program participants, known as Fivers, grow and develop along three pathways, Healthy Life Choices, Education and Careers, and Service and Leadership, representing the journey they take in our program.

A CATALYST FOR CHANGE: Staff members build relationships with children during a two-week experience at Camp Fiver, an award-winning, residential summer camp, located in the peaceful hamlet of Poolville, NY. The intensive camp experience provides a fast-track to bonding with staff members who become long-term mentors.

A UNIQUE PROGRAM MODEL: We follow camp up with intentional out-of-school time programs including one-on-one mentoring meetings, character-cultivating activities, educational workshops and career readiness training. Programs are geared towards key leverage points in children's lives: the entrance into middle school, high school, college, and careers.

CULTIVATING CHARACTER YIELDS RESULTS: As research shows, achievement in social and emotional learning leads to increases in high school graduation rates, postsecondary enrollment, postsecondary completion, employment rates, and average wages. Fiver programs are aimed at building social and emotional competencies that lead to success in school, careers and life.

92% of 3rd graders tried a new class or activity that they have never tried before.

97% of 8th graders reported Fiver taught them the skills to resist negative peer pressure.

86% of graduates reported Fiver helped them apply healthy conflict resolution skills.

SERVICE & LEADERSHIP

94% of 3rd graders reported Fiver helped them understand it's okay to be different.

97% of 8th graders believe that they are prepared to overcome challenges in their lives.

94% of graduates reported Fiver helped them compassionately confront prejudices.

EDUCATION & CAREERS

84% of 3rd graders reported that Fiver taught them how to feel confident when introducing themselves.

90% of 8th graders reported that Fiver helped them step outside their comfort zone.

100% of 12th graders reported Fiver helped them understand their options and develop a post-high school plan.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS:

ANNUAL BENEFIT The Fiver Annual Benefit took place on May 21 at Gotham Hall and raised over \$700,000. Kendis Gibson hosted an evening Celebrating our Fiver Stories, including the entire room joining together in a Camp Fiver song.

ADVOCATES COMMITTEE The Fiver Advocates volunteer committee organized a 5k run to support Fiver's mission. The 5k took place in Brooklyn's beautiful Prospect Park on May 19, 2019, raising nearly \$9,000!

YOUNG PROFESSIONALS COMMITTEE Our Young Professionals Committee hosted their first annual Summer Soiree, raising over \$5,000 for our mission. The cocktail and networking reception brought together a diverse group of young professionals passionate about giving back. The room was filled with so much enthusiasm for Fiver.

ALUMNI NETWORK The 2018 graduates were inducted and our past graduating classes were celebrated during January's Alumni Weekend. Our annual reunion dinner had Alumni from the class of 2007 to the class of 2018 in attendance and our 2008 graduating class celebrated their ten year anniversary. In June, we held our first Alumni Reunion at Camp Fiver. We hosted over 100 Fiver graduates and former staff for a weekend of reconnecting with old friends, making new ones, enjoying camp, and thinking about the future of our Alumni programming.

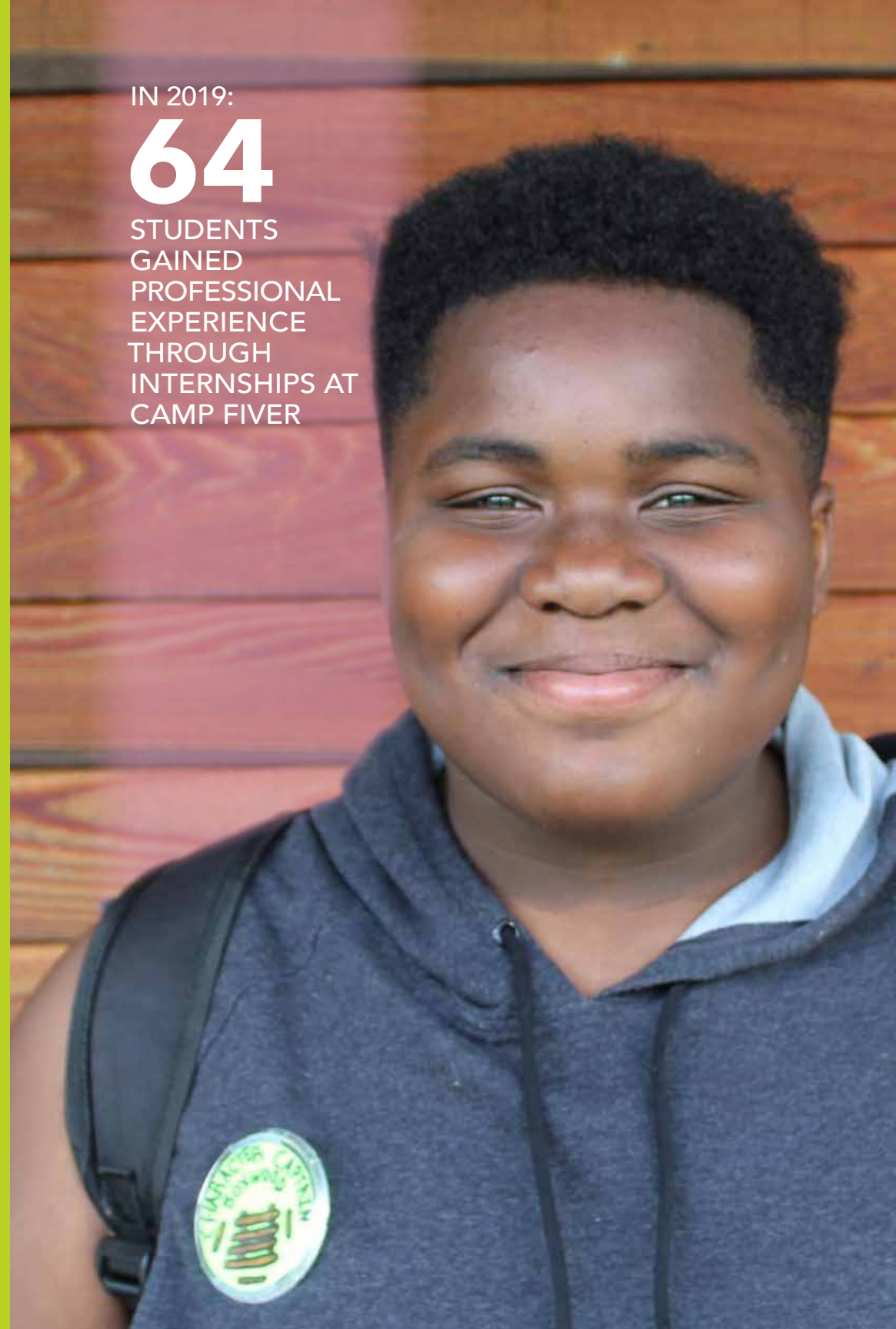

FIVER HAS HAD A PROFOUND IMPACT ON MY LIFE. I would not be where I am today if it wasn't for Fiver and the generosity and love of so many amazing people that make it what it is. I was eight years old when I first became involved with the organization. Like any eight-year-old leaving home for their first sleep-away camp experience, I was both excited and nervous. I remember that first long bus ride upstate and arriving on that beautiful

campus terrified. It was a fleeting feeling because as soon as I stepped off that bus, I was greeted with such enthusiasm and love and was part of the Fiver Family. Born in Brooklyn, New York, to an immigrant who worked very hard to provide the best life for me, there weren't many opportunities to escape city life for nature. While some kids regularly have the opportunity to participate in team

sports or aquatic activities, Camp Fiver provided that retreat for me—a place to do sports, to go swimming, to ride horses. What makes Fiver truly special is that it is so much more than that—ethics classes, public speaking, how to give handshakes, eye contact. Without me realizing it, Fiver was providing me with valuable life lessons and shaping the person I would become. I took our values seriously, so every summer I would try to excel at a new attribute so that I could earn that coveted dog tag. For those two to three weeks every year, Camp Fiver was where I wanted to be.

Fiver was not only a local support system, but also provided year-round engagements, summer internships, and even college preparation. After I graduated in 2010, I enrolled at Amherst College, a school we toured on a college trip. I graduated in Computer Science and moved to work in Ohio. Currently, I work for a nonprofit, Battelle Memorial

Institute. Although I am far away, Fiver will always have my heart. I am married now, and we have a toddler who I hope to one day introduce into the Fiver Family. I hope to instill in him those same values Fiver instilled in me and share with him those special memories. I am beyond grateful for this organization. Once a Fiver, always a Fiver.
